

CBBF CODE OF ETHICS FOR ATHLETES **AT THE 2006 IFBB WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS**

We, the CBBF bodybuilders, body fitness and fitness athletes, realizing that our conduct reflects on the good name of the CBBF sport of bodybuilding, body fitness and fitness and particularly our country of Canada and realizing the responsibility thereby placed upon us as representatives of the IFBB, CBBF and our provincial associations and to a greater extent as ambassadors of Canada, pledge ourselves:

1. To fulfill our responsibility to society, to the officials, to our fellow Team Canada members, to the CBBF photographers, to the CBBF web site providers and the administrators of the IFBB/CBBF and our provincial associations.
2. To compete in the best of conditions and to the best of our ability at the IFBB World Championships.
3. To respect our opponents and fellow members of Team Canada on equal terms in the spirit of friendly rivalry and good sportsmanship.
4. To respect the IFBB and CBBF Constitutions, Rules and Bylaws as well as the rules of the IFBB World Championships.
5. To accept the decisions of the officials in the spirit of good sportsmanship.
6. To honour the special trust conferred upon us by our participation in, and by our representation of, the IFBB, CBBF and particularly Canada, at the IFBB World Championships, and to adhere to any and all standards of personal conduct expected of us.
7. To oppose the use of performance enhancing drugs and to compete drug free.
8. To cooperate with all members of Team Canada, IFBB and CBBF officials and administrators, i.e. photographers, web site providers, etc.
9. To be aware of and **strictly follow** specific times for the IFBB World Championship events, i.e. weigh in, dinners, etc. and **any and all directions set down by the CBBF, host country of the IFBB World Championships and the IFBB.**
10. To confer with CBBF officials regarding travel arrangements, arrival and departure times and flights, times, names, etc.; no less than 2 weeks prior to departure.
11. Must make self-accountable at all times to the CBBF delegate, from time of arrival to time of departure.
12. To be an ambassador for Canada and a member of Team Canada from departure from Canada until returning, during the entire venture to the IFBB World Championships.
13. If we fail to abide by **all the above statements** we realize we may be **removed** from the IFBB World Championships at any time and **suspended** for a period of not less than **2-years** from the event and possibly suspended for **life** from competing in any IFBB, CBBF or Provincial Association event.
We may also be removed from the host hotel of the IFBB World Championship event, may not receive funds agreed to and must provide any funds outstanding to the CBBF.
